



**A Cape For Emma

Makes a adult small/child's large

3 skeins Super Bulky Boucle Yarn - about 170 yards (Lion Boucle used in sample) MC

1 Skein 64 yards Fun Fur CC

30 inch Markham adj. loom with 88 pegs in regular gage

Loom hook

Crochet hook

Crochet Cast On 88 stitches in CC using a single strand. E-wrap knit 6 rows (1 ½ inches) in CC.

Change to MC. E-wrap knit 6 rows.

Decrease 1: Decrease 2 stitches at each corner of the loom by moving the end loop to the next peg. Move in the adjustable end. This should give you 4 decreases. Then, on one side of the loom, move the loop on the 6th peg to 7th. Do this on the other side opposite. Move over loops on pegs 1 - 5 on both sides. Move in the adjustable end where the decrease was made. There should be 82 stitches. Treat the double stitches as one, and e-wrap knit until the cape measures 10 inches from the start.

Decrease 2: Move every third peg loop over one. Knit over the doubled stitches. Shift the stitches toward the center, gradually moving in the adjustable side pegs, until there are 62 stitches, and no empty pegs.

E-wrap knit until the cape measures 12 ½ inches from the start.

Decrease 3: Move every third peg loop over one. Knit over the doubled stitches. Shift the stitches over toward the center, gradually moving in the adjustable side pegs, until there are 42 stitches, and no empty pegs.

E-wrap knit 2 rows.

Decrease 4: Move every third peg loop over one. Knit over the doubled stitches. Shift the stitches over toward the center, gradually moving in the side pegs, until there are 28 stitches remaining, and no empty pegs.

E-wrap knit until the cape measures 14 inches from the start.

Purl 1 row

Knit 1 row

Purl 1 row

Knit 1 row

Bind off very loosely for the neck.
