



Fancy Clutch Purse

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This pattern is a great way to introduce anyone to flat panel decreasing. With its easy open bag using the basic e-wrap technique anyone will have fun creating this delightful purse for you or as a gorgeous gift.

Materials used:

60 peg ½ gauge round or oval loom
Yarn needle with extra large eye
Pick
Yarn guide
Size 'K' crochet hook
Lg. Button of your choice for closure

Yarns used in this project:

Fiore Celebration by Sullivans 2 skeins
Embrace by Sierra Pacific Crafts Color Sal Xbulky 3 skeins
Dream Girl by Yarn Bee 1 skein

Note bag as shown above done in variations of variegated purples any xbulky yarn will do as your primary coloring. The Celebration is a multi accent and the dream girl was used for the flap accent coloring.

Optional Items used:

Any purse handles of your choice. They usually come in packages of 2 only one was used in this design. If not using a purse handle an I-Cord handle can be used.

Main Bag Portion:

Using one strand xbulky yarn and one strand of the Celebration accent, cast on all 60 pegs of the loom in the round. Use the basic e-wrap and KO one over one method for 50 rounds. You can increase the amount of rounds depending on how deep you wish your purse to be. After completing the final row drop and cut the Celebration yarn and weave in ends to secure. Add one strand of Dream Girl.

Bag Flap:

For the remainder of the bag you will be working on pegs 1-29 only in the flat panel decrease method.

- () E-wrap pegs 1- 29 ko
- () E-wrap pegs 29-1 ko
- () Place Stitch 1 on peg 2 and Stitch 29 on peg 28, e-wrap pegs 3-27 KO pegs 2-28
- () E-wrap pegs 28-2 KO
- () E-wrap pegs 2-28 KO
- () Using crochet hook size 'K', place loop from peg 60 onto hook. SC each loop off the loom from peg 59-30, knot off and weave in ends. (You will have ½ of your loom now with working wraps)
- () Place Stitch 28 on peg 27 and stitch 2 on peg 3 e-wrap pegs 4-26 KO all pegs
- () E-wrap pegs 3-27 KO
- () E-wrap 27-3 KO
- () Place stitch 3 on peg 4 and stitch 27 on peg 26, e-wrap 5-25, KO 4-26
- () E-wrap 26-4 KO
- () E-wrap 4-26 KO
- () Place stitch 26 on 25 and stitch 4 on 5, e-wrap 24-6 KO 25-5
- () E-wrap 5-25 KO
- () E-wrap 25-5 KO
- () Place Stitch 5 on 6 and 25 on 24, e-wrap 7-23, KO 6-24
- () E-wrap 24-6 KO
- () E-wrap 6-24 KO
- () Place stitch 24 on 23 and Stitch 6 on 7, e-wrap 22-8, KO
- () e-wrap 7-23 KO
- () E-wrap 23-7 KO
- () Place Stitch 7 on 8 and Stitch 23 on 22, e-wrap 9-21, KO 8-22
- () E-wrap 22-8 KO
- () E-wrap 8-22 KO
- () Place stitch 22 on 21 and stitch 8 on 9, e-wrap 20-10, KO 21-9
- () E-wrap 9-21 KO
- () E-wrap 21-9 KO
- () Place Stitch 9 on 10 and stitch 21 on 20, e-wrap 11-19, KO 10-20
- () E-wrap 20-10 KO
- () E-wrap 10-20 KO
- () Place stitch 20 on 19 and stitch 10 on 11, e-wrap 18-12, KO 19-11
- () E-wrap 11-19 KO
- () E-wrap 19-11 KO
- () Place stitch 11 on 12 and stitch 19 on 18, e-wrap 13-17, KO 12-18
- () E-wrap 18-12 KO

- () E-wrap 12-18 KO
- () Place stitch 18 on 17 and stitch 12 on 13, e-wrap 16-14, KO 17-13
- () E-wrap 13-17 KO
- () E-wrap 17-13 KO

- () Work stitches 17-13 off loom using the size 'K' hook with the crochet removal method.
- () Chain 5 and slip stitch into loop 17, knot off and weave in ends.

Finishing Purse:

- () Turn bag inside out and using a soft bristle brush lightly brush the flap to fluff yarn out.
- () Find the center of your bag and attach Button with needle and thread so it is secure and that the loop you made in your chain 5 secures the flap closed
- () Now this is really up to your personal choice...you can attach bamboo handles to each side of your bag or loop stitch a round ring handle or you can make an I-Cord handle depending on your preference.
