



Felted Britch Bag

This bag was loomed on a 48 peg regular gauge round loom, with britch handspun wool yarn. Any wool yarn should work.

Loom Bag 1/3 size larger than you'd like finished bag to be.

Remove the bag from the loom with the Open Removal Method, chain stitch one between each removed stitch.

Stitch the bottom of the bag, envelope style. >----<

Felting:

After looming, the bag was put in a nylon laundry bag to be washed in the washer with hot water and soap.

To dry; place the wet bag on a thick towel. Occasionally, turn it over and inside out. Wool takes a long time to thoroughly dry.

To shape the bag: when the bag is just damp, about 8 hours, place it on a foam form to complete the drying process.

To make the form;

The foam form may be cut to the desired size, from a firm foam pillow form.
