



Keyhole Handle Felted Tote
Pattern created by Teresa Bowman (C) 2006

Supplies: Loom - FG 80 peg loom, Yarn - 6 oz. 100% WW Wool Yarn (wpi 11), Yarn Needle

Notes: Pattern is worked in rounds using one strand of yarn.

*Place marker on 1st peg to indicate beginning of round.

Cast on.

Round 1: Knit in single stitch.

Rounds 2-?: Repeat round 1. Repeat until desired length of bag is reached. (I prefer a tall bag so my sample was 14" in length at this point)

For Keyhole Handle: Begin at marker (1st peg), knit 15, bind off 10, knit 30, bind off 10, knit 15.

Next Round: Knit 15, cast on 10, knit 30, cast on 10, knit 15.

Knit 10 more rows in single stitch.

Bind off – Remove from loom.

Finishing: Sew seam straight across bottom of bag and secure yarn. Weave in yarn ends.

Felt: Using your favorite method.

Size: Sample – unfelted 11" wide x 16" tall, Felted – 9" wide x 12" tall

This is an excellent pattern to use up all your scraps of wool yarn – the more colors, the more vibrant bag.
